



Plagiarism and Failing Grade Policy

Here at Wild Rose College, we are proud to send our graduates into the world with adequate skills to source quality herbal information, and the ability to use that information uniquely and creatively. It is a pleasure for us to read your herbal research paper and learn more about the topic you've chosen as well as understand your unique perspective. However, to graduate as an awesome and resourceful herbalist, we need to hold some standards. Please read, review, and familiarize yourself with the policies below:

*Plagiarism is recognized as any information included in your research paper that is not in your own words and has not been cited properly. Wild Rose College does not accept information that has been copied and pasted from external sources. All information must be presented in your own words.

If when marking a research paper, the Wild Rose College team finds evidence of plagiarism being used the student will be immediately failed and their paper returned for revision. The student will have a minimum of 1 month to a maximum of 3 months to submit their edited and revised research paper to the Wild Rose College team for marking. If the student has passed the one-year timeline provided to write their research paper, they will be allowed an extension at no cost to revise their research paper.

If a research paper is to be failed after it has been submitted a second time, the student must re-purchase the Research Paper and will begin an entirely new topic to submit. Approval must be obtained.

Note: The above plagiarism policies will also apply to students who fail their research paper assignment due to other reasons.
